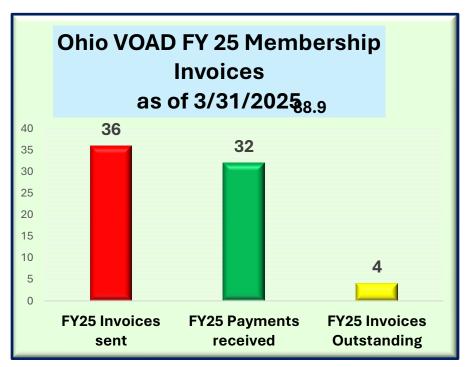

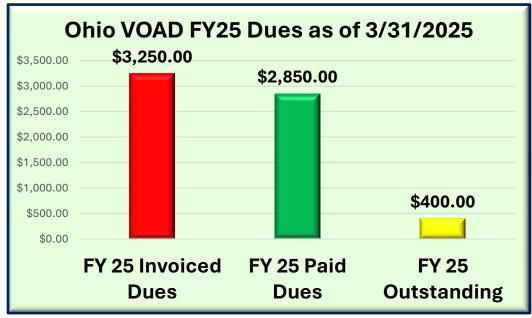

A. QuickBooks

- C. Complete Membership review and produce accurate Membership lists from QuickBooks -In Progress
- D. Identify outside volunteer third party auditor (CPA) to assist in end-of-year (November 2025) audit.
- E. Identify long term storage location for financial and email passwords.

- $\sqrt{}$ Proposal to eliminate support for two old domains (long term cost savings).
- $\sqrt{}$ Resolved differences between QuickBooks accounts 1020 and 10210) should not reoccur.
- $\sqrt{}$ Roy Nelson resolved the "Undeposited" funds (uncollectible)
- $\sqrt{}$ Roy Nelson created a standard way to categorize bad debts (aka "uncollectible"). We now have a bad debt account to track these invoices.
- $\sqrt{}$ Identified a standard way to accept donations.
- $\sqrt{}$ Signed up for ZELLE on our PNC checking account. We can now accept donations (such as the Silent Auction) electronically. This could negate the need for PayPal more to come.
